BECOME A FOSTER PAW-RENT 💞

Foster carers play a vital role in caring for greyhounds, offering them essential care and engaging them in enrichment activities like walks and exposure to new objects and experiences. Our dedicated GAP team provides continuous support and advice to our foster families throughout the entire process.

What is provided:

- Foster Carer Training Manual
- Skills sessions may be held periodically throughout the year
- Foster carers providing behavioural rehabilitation may be provided one-on-one training sessions
- Supplies of dry dog kibble and any medication required for the duration of the foster period
- Dog equipment including lead, muzzle, blanket, dog bed, clam shell, toys and a dog coat
- 24-hour access to out-of-hours phone number in case of emergencies

"I have had Rosie since 2019 and she will be 11 this month. I wanted a greyhound who had energy to burn, because I run and wanted a running companion (who has been the perfect match, as she is always up for a run!). Everyone loves Rosie at Parkrun 📆 🏂, we always get people coming up to us to pat Rosie. Rosie gets super excited when she sees me in my running gear as she knows she is coming out for a run. Most people admire her running style as she does a light trot beside me. We try and do a sprint finish although to be honest I am doing my best to run fast, but she hardly busts out into a sprint, which is probably a good thing!

I run with Rosie about 2-3 times a week, otherwise she gets a walk, because if not, she barks at the door to go out for a walk, so she keeps me accountable."
