The Greyhound Adoption Program (GAP) QLD is run by the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) and is dedicated to finding homes for greyhounds that have retired from racing or are otherwise in need of a family.

### **HELPFUL GREYHOUND CARE TIPS**



**Greyhound Fibrinolytic Syndrome...** what does it really mean?



It has been reported that up to 30 per cent of greyhounds suffer from a bleeding disorder that can be potentially life threatening. Greyhound fibrinolytic syndrome is also known as "delayed bleeding" as bleeding generally occurs 36 to 48 hours after a surgical procedure or injury. Bleeding problems can range in severity from bruising, bleeding from wounds to severe, life-threatening internal bleeding. It often manifests as skin bruising, extending from a surgical wound to surrounding areas, which can persist for days. In some cases, this can be associated with active bleeding from wounds and delayed sloughing of skin and underlying tissues.

# TRAVELLING HOME WITH YOUR NEWLY ADOPTED GREYHOUND ##

Greyhounds love to curl up on the softest of beds. You can help make their first car journey with you more comfortable by placing a dog bed in the backseat or boot of your car. If you have the greyhound in the backseat area, a dog car seat hammock is also highly recommended.

When you adopt a GAP greyhound as part of your starter kit, a doggy seat belt is supplied for your newest fur–mily's safety.

## GREEN COLLAR ASSESSMENT 💙





If you didn't adopt your greyhound with GAP, did you know you can still have your retired racer assessed for a green collar?

Green collar accreditation provides an exemption from muzzling in a local council area where muzzling would otherwise be required under the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008.

Our adoption fee is \$100. All GAP greyhounds have a uniquely numbered green collar, are desexed, heartworm tested, receive a full dental assessment including a scale and polish, are vaccinated, microchipped, and they come to you with up-to-date flea, tick and worming treatments and a Greyhound starter kit to assist you on your adoption journey.

All GAP greyhounds receive lifetime registration with Central Animal Records microchip registry. More information on our adoption process can be found here.
